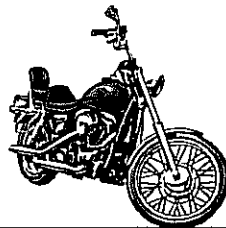
Benefits-Camp Courage and Little Bravehearts Bereavement Camps

Camp Courage is free of charge to all who participate.

At Camp Courage, campers learn a variety of ways to express their grief, through journaling, music, physical activity, creating memory boxes and other guided activities. In addition, campers are encouraged to practice sharing their feelings and provide support to one another in a safe, caring environment with small groups of peers and adult volunteers.
